

As members of the Monroe County business community, you have the opportunity to positively impact the stability of your workforce by supporting their need for reliable childcare while they work. The *Florida Chamber of Commerce's Untapped Potential* report identified a lack of affordable childcare as one of the main drivers behind employee absenteeism, costing Florida's employers \$3.47 billion per year, and the state nearly \$5.4 billion per year in economic value. Investing in early care and education will not only yield a benefit to your business, but to the future workforce of Florida as well.

BACKGROUND

The Early Learning Coalition of Miami-Dade/Monroe serves as the local administrator of the School Readiness program, as designated under Chapter 1002, Florida Statutes. This program provides assistance to low incomeworking families to ensure that children have access to high-quality early care and education, while allowing parents to remain in the workforce. Many working parents across Monroe County — in retail, hospitality, restaurants, and "essential" jobs — are beneficiaries of child care services through Florida's School Readiness Program.

In order to qualify for the School Readiness program, parents must be working and/or enrolled in an educational institution, with a household income that does not exceed 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (\$45,000 for a family of 4: 2 children & 2 adults). Currently, the income eligibility threshold does not align with Monroe County's high cost-of-living, creating fiscal cliffs for families who have to decide between accepting a small wage increase and potentially losing critical subsidies, or leaving the workforce altogether, moving further away from self-sufficiency.

YOU can make an impact on the future of Monroe County's economy. Here's how:

Employers

Help improve your bottom line and employee recruitment, retention and attendance:

- Provide a child care stipend directly to your employees.
- Reimburse a local early care and education program for a percentage of the cost of child care for your employees' children. Contributions made on behalf of your employees are eligible for tax credits authorized by the Florida Legislature in 2024.

Municipalities

- Provide a grant to the Early Learning Coalition to support child care for low-income working families that do not qualify for the School Readiness Program.
- Local municipalities can include in their legislative priorities the need to increase the income eligibility threshold of the School Readiness program above the current threshold of 150% Federal Poverty Level (\$45,000 for a family of 4).

Individual Donors

• Contribute to the Community Foundation of the Florida Keys Child Care Scholarship Fund, an early education tuition assistance program.

Childcare access and affordability is the #1 barrier for parents returning to the workforce.



The Benefit to YOU:

- Employee Recruitment/Retention and Satisfaction: Child care support can be an attractive perk for potential employees, especially for working parents. Offering child care assistance can enhance employee satisfaction and retention, as parents often struggle to balance work and family responsibilities.

- **Tax Incentives:** Childcare assistance provided by an employer is a tax-deductible "ordinary and necessary" business expense under Internal Revenue Codes Section 162.

MILE

Mile Markers – What's the Deal?

MILE US 1 is used to travel the islands of the Florida Keys. Location: along the hightway are expressed by Mile Marker numbers. The ZERO Mile Marker is found in Key West. Mile Marker numbers continue to increase until the pass through the Monroe County line at Mile Marker 112, north of Key Largo. Look for small green signs with white

numbers posted at each mile along US 1 (these used to be the original mile posts installed along the old railroad bed).

Special note: Mile marker references are commonly used in localaddresses. When there is a B or O this denotes either Bayside (north-Gulf of Mexico side) or Oceanside (south-Atlantic Ocean side) location.

May is Mental Health Awareness Month

Many people in the U.S. are affected by mental illness each year. These numbers are also powerful tools for raising public awareness, and removing negative thoughts about people with mental illnesses (National Alliance on Mental Illness):

1 in 5 U.S. adults experience mental illness each year

1 in 20 U.S. adults experience serious mental illness each year

1 in 6 U.S. youth aged 6-17 experience a mental health disorder each year 50% of all lifetime mental illness begins by age 14, and 75% by age 24 Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death among people aged 10-14

If you or someone you know is struggling or in crisis, help is available.

Steps to improve mental health, focus on self-care, healthy habits, and building supportive relationships. Prioritize things like exercise, a balanced diet, and sufficient sleep. Consider practicing mindfulness or meditation, and seek professional help when needed.

1. Prioritize Self-Care: Exercise: Regular physical activity, even a brisk walk, can boost mood and reduce stress.

Healthy Diet: Focus on whole foods, fruits, and vegetables for optimal brain function.

Sleep: Aim for 7-9 hours of quality sleep per night to improve cognitive function and emotional regulation.

Mindfulness and Meditation: Practicing mindfulness and meditation can help reduce stress and improve emotional regulation.

Limit Screen Time: Excessive social media use can negatively impact mental health, so consider limiting screen time and engaging in other activities.

2. Build Healthy Habits: Set Goals: Identifying and working towards specific goals can provide a sense of purpose and accomplishment.

Practice Gratitude: Regularly reflecting on things you appreciate can shift your focus towards positive emotions.

Take Breaks: Incorporate regular breaks into your day to avoid burnout and allow for rest and reflection.

3. Strengthen Social Connections: Connect with Loved Ones: Maintain strong relationships with family and friends to build a support network.

Volunteer: Helping others can boost your mood and provide a sense of pur-

YES, WE RECYCLE: COUNTY STAFF AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS TOUR REUTER'S RECYCLING FACILITY

MONROE COUNTY, FL – Recently, a group of Monroe County and City of Key West staff, along with local Florida Keys environmental advocates, visited Reuter's Recycling Facility on the mainland in Pembroke Pines. The tour provided valuable insights into the single-stream recycling process used for Monroe County's recyclables.

The visit provided a deeper understanding of the county's recycling system and the challenges involved in processing materials. Attendees were surprised by the complexity of the sorting and processing to prepare recyclable materials for the commodity market. The tour emphasized the importance of proper recycling practices and the detrimental impact of contamination on the system's efficiency.

"I think there is still a large portion of the population that does not understand the process, specifically WHAT can be recycled," said Kacey Hunt, executive assistant for Commissioner Michelle Lincoln. "I left that experience wishing I could take everyone to Reuter's because it is so eye-opening and informative."

DID YOU KNOW: Reuter's is building a new recycling facility expected to open by 2026. The new facility will process materials more efficiently, doubling its capacity from 35 to 70 tons per hour. Additionally, research is underway to expand the types of plastics that can be accepted for processing.


