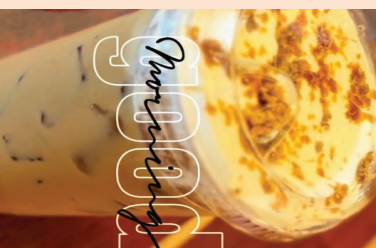

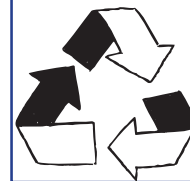

Celebrate Independence Day in the Florida Keys by prioritizing sun, heat, and water safety, leaving personal fireworks to the professionals to protect both yourselves and the local ecosystem.

As you prepare to celebrate Independence Day in the spectacular Florida Keys, combining the thrill of the holiday with essential health and safety practices ensures your weekend remains memorable for the right reasons.

July is synonymous with peak summer heat, vibrant marine activities, and community celebrations. Here is how you can stay safe, healthy, and environmentally conscious while enjoying everything the island chain has to offer.

Beat the Extreme Summer Heat

Florida sun can be relentless, and high humidity significantly increases the risk of heat-related illnesses like heat exhaustion and heat stroke.

• **Hydrate Constantly:** Drink plenty of water throughout the day, even before you feel thirsty. Limit alcohol and caffeine, as they can accelerate dehydration.

• **Seek Shade:** Try to limit direct sun exposure during peak hours, usually between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

• **Sun Protection:** Apply a broad-spectrum sunscreen with an SPF of at least 30, and reapply every two hours (or immediately after swimming or heavy sweating). A wide-brimmed hat and UV-blocking sunglasses provide excellent extra protection.

• **Watch for Warning Signs:** Symptoms of heat exhaustion include dizziness, nausea, headache, and heavy sweating. If someone shows signs of confusion or a rapid, weak pulse, seek medical attention immediately.

Boating and Water Safety

Being on the water is a staple of the Keys lifestyle, but the ocean environment requires caution.

• **Life Jackets:** Ensure everyone—especially children and weak swimmers—wears a U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket while swimming or on a boat.

• **Safe Boating Practices:** Avoid boating under the influence (BUI). Always ensure

your vessel has the proper required safety equipment, such as working navigation lights if out past sunset, fire extinguishers, and visual distress signals.

• **Currents and Swimming:** If you are caught in a rip current, stay calm. Do not fight the current; instead, swim parallel to the shore until you are free of it, then swim to land.

Leave the Fireworks to the Pros

Personal fireworks (including firecrackers and aers) are a leading cause of severe burns and eye injuries, and using them poses a massive risk of sparking brush fires in Florida's dry summer conditions.

• **Official Displays:** Leave the pyrotechnics to the experts by attending permitted municipal events, such as the famous Star-Spangled Celebration in Key West, or community events in Marathon and Islamorada.

• **Protect the Environment:** Unregulated fireworks and loud explosions can devastate the delicate Florida Keys ecosystem. The noise and bright lights cause extreme

distress to local wildlife and can cause protected shorebirds or sea turtles to abandon their nests.

Protect Your Pets

The loud pops and flashes of fireworks are a primary reason pets run away or panic on the Fourth of July.

• **Secure Your Animals:** Keep your pets in a safe, cool, and comfortable indoor space away from the noise.

• **Update Identification:** Ensure your pet's collar has updated identification tags and consider having them microchipped in case they get lost during the festivities.

Make sure to touch base with your local veterinarian for any new or improved methods to calm your pets anxiety during the holiday.

By planning ahead, staying hydrated, and respecting the unique environment of the Florida Keys, you and your loved ones can celebrate our nation's independence safely and responsibly.

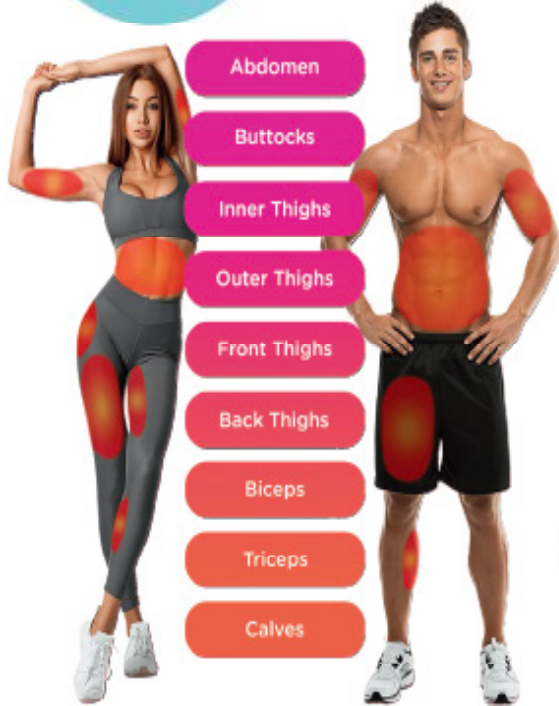

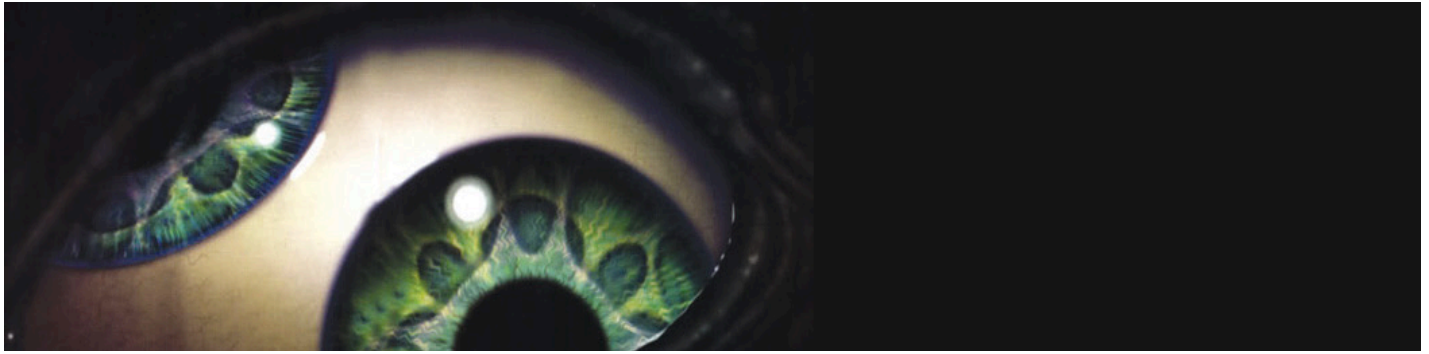

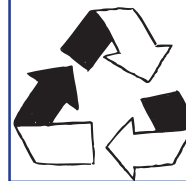

The Future Of Air Service At Florida Keys Marathon International Airport (MTH)

Commercial service at Marathon International Airport is not ready for takeoff just yet, but the wheels are in motion to bring a commercial airline back to the Middle Keys facility.

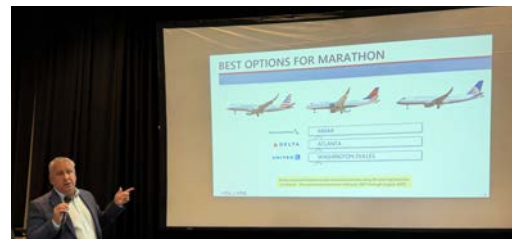
Executive Director of Airports Richard Strickland gave an update to a crowd of 80 guests at the June 16, 2026, Marathon Chamber of Commerce luncheon. The following information is intended as a guide for the public as to how service will be facilitated at MTH.

How would commercial service make its return to the Middle Keys?

The first step in the process is complete: the Monroe County Board of County Commissioners at its May meeting unanimously approved a resolution supporting the growth of air service at MTH and to waive landing fees and terminal rent for the first two years of service from a commercial airline.

How will MTH be able to fund the return of commercial service?

The airport has applied for a Small Community Air Service Development (SCASD) grant, a competitive program administered by the U.S. Department of Transportation. It is designed to help communities reduce the financial risk for airlines that are considering starting service in a new market. The SCASD grant often requires a local community contribution or incentive package.

Mile Markers – What's the Deal?
US 1 is used to travel the islands of the Florida Keys.
Location: along the highway are expressed by Mile Marker numbers. The ZERO Mile Marker is found in Key West. Mile Marker numbers continue to increase until the pass through the Monroe County line at Mile Marker 112, north of Key Largo. Look for small green signs with white numbers posted at each mile along US 1 (these used to be the original mile posts installed along the old railroad bed).
Special note: Mile marker references are commonly used in local addresses. When there is a B or O this denotes either Bayside (north-Gulf of Mexico side) or Oceanside (south-Atlantic Ocean side) location.

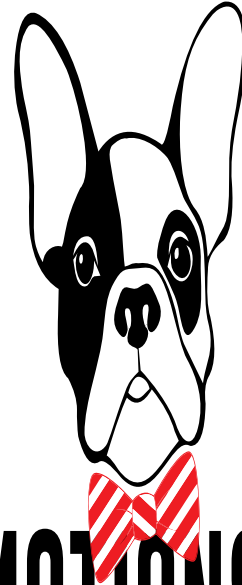
MONROE COUNTY, FL SHARES GUIDANCE AS SARGASSUM IMPACTS CONTINUE ACROSS THE FLORIDA KEYS –is coordinating with state regulating agencies and local partners to publish guidance on the widespread influx of sargassum grass impacting ocean-side shorelines and canals throughout the Florida Keys.

Sargassum grass is a naturally occurring seaweed found in the ocean that is essential to protecting habitat for a variety of marine life, including sea turtles, crabs, shrimp, and other juvenile sea creatures. Influxes that wash ashore or into canals can become a nuisance, and as the sargassum decays, it produces a hydrogen sulfide gas. This year, the influx of sargassum grass is causing periodic inconveniences in some areas and contributing to fish kills.

The county has been coordinating with the *Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP)*, which provided staff with an update on current conditions and regulatory guidance. According to DEP, this year's sargassum bloom is widespread and extends throughout the Keys along the ocean side of the island chain and is expected to continue throughout the summer. *It's important for residents to know that sargassum grass is protected offshore and that regulations govern its removal.* Clearing sargassum from canals may provide temporary relief, but it is not a long-term solution. Additional blooms are anticipated, and residents should be aware that removed material will likely be replaced by future influxes. While removal is not suggested, residents should be aware of the state regulations governing sargassum removal. These can be found at myfwc.com/research/about/ear/sargassum/.

Health Considerations

The Florida Department of Health advises that decomposing sargassum can produce hydrogen sulfide gas, which has a strong odor similar to rotten eggs. While the gas is generally diluted outdoors, it may irritate the eyes, nose, and throat and can affect individuals with asthma or other respiratory conditions more severely. Residents experiencing irritation are encouraged to limit exposure, avoid direct contact with decomposing seaweed, and seek medical advice if symptoms persist. Monroe County Parks and Beaches crews are continuing onshore sargassum cleanup efforts at Harry Harris Park and other county-owned beaches using county equipment, including clamshell trucks. 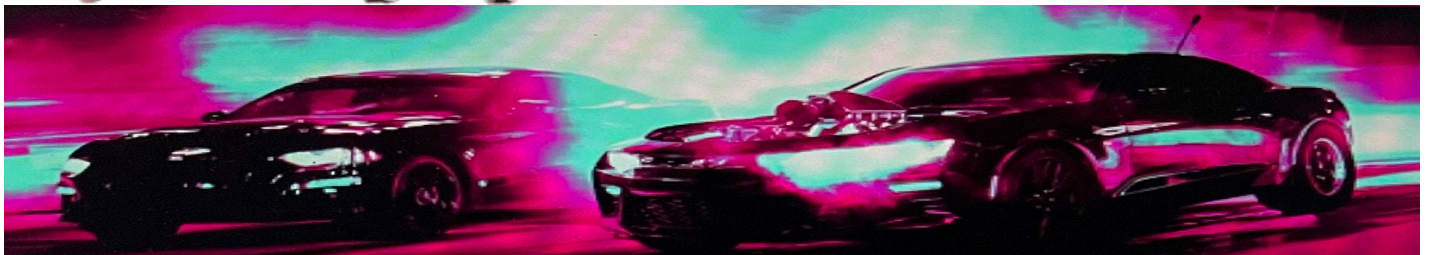
