September is National Preparedness Month

Sponsored by Federal Emergency Management Agency as a reminder that disasters can strike at any time and it's good to have a plan!!

The threat of hurricanes is very real for Florida during the six-month long Atlantic hurricane season, which runs from June 1 until November 30.

The peak of hurricane season occurs between mid-August and late October, when the waters in the equatorial Atlantic and Gulf of Mexico have warmed enough to help support the development of tropical waves.

A common misconception in Florida is that there are

parts of the state that do not get hurricanes. Since 1850, all of Florida's coastline has been impacted by at least one hurricane. And regardless of where the hurricane makes landfall in the state, the impacts can be felt hundreds of miles away.

The National Safety Council recommends the following general precautions that apply to many disaster situations:

• Make sure at least one family member knows first aid and CPR

- Download the FEMA app for resources, weather alerts and safety tips
- Have a family communication plan in place; all members of the family should review and practice the plan
- Have all family members' and other important phone numbers written down or memorized
- Have an emergency kit in your car and at least three days of food and water at home
 - Be sure to store all

important documents – birth certificates, insurance policies, etc. – in a fire-proof safe or safety deposit box

• Know how to shut off utilities

If you have no family or friends, reach out to your neighbors, your local church or health department so that you can have a plan, if and whenever disaster strikes.





Mile Markers - What's the Deal?


US 1 is used to travel the islands of the Florida Keys. Location: along the hightway are expressed by Mile Marker numbers. The ZERO Mile Marker is found in Key West. Mile Marker numbers continue to increase until the pass through the Monroe County line at Mile Marker 112, north of Key Largo. Look for small green signs with white numbers posted at each mile along US 1 (these used to be the original mile posts installed along the old railroad bed).

Special note: Mile marker references are commonly used in local addresses. When there is a B or O this denotes either Bayside (north-Gulf of Mexico side) or Oceanside (south-Atlantic Ocean side) location.






