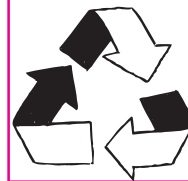

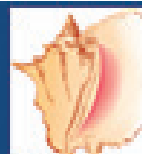

**TINA BOAN NAMED
MONROE COUNTY'S
ASSISTANT COUNTY
ADMINISTRATOR**



– The Monroe County Board of County Commissioners approved the promotion of Senior Director of Budget and Finance Tina Boan to assistant county administrator. This promotion comes as part of the county's ongoing efforts to strengthen its leadership team and ensure the efficient management of resources for the benefit of the community.

For almost 20 years, Boan has overseen budget development and financial operations, including managing the \$716 million budget, financial planning, and fund management. She has been instrumental in guiding Monroe County's fiscal strategy, improving financial operations, and ensuring long-term economic stability. Numerous times in her county career, she has been called upon to assist other departments with training, fiscal oversight, and operations. She is also the lead expert in after-storm funding, reporting, and obtaining reimbursement from FEMA and other agencies that assist in recovery efforts.

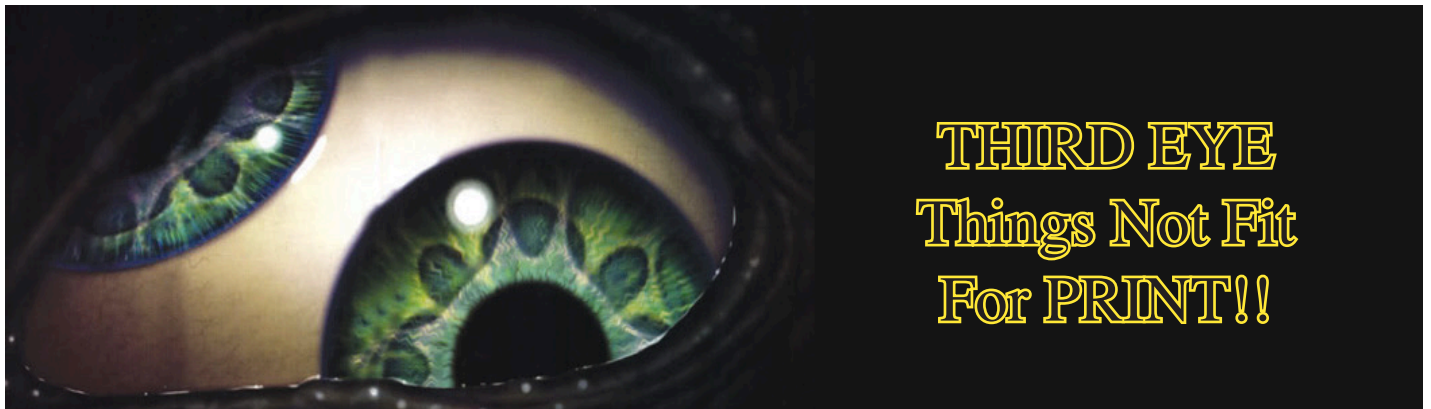

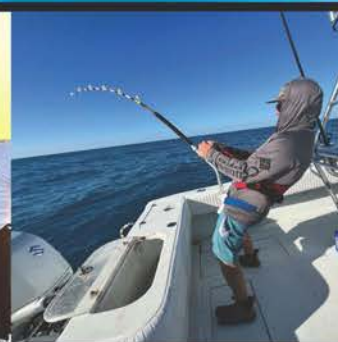

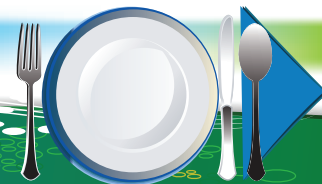

Mile Markers – What's the Deal?

US 1 is used to travel the islands of the Florida Keys.

Location: along the highway are expressed by Mile Marker numbers. The **ZERO Mile Marker** is found in Key West. Mile Marker numbers continue to increase until the pass through the Monroe County line at **Mile Marker 112, north of Key Largo**. Look for small green signs with white numbers posted at each mile along US 1 (these used to be the original mile posts installed along the old railroad bed).

Special note: Mile marker references are commonly used in local addresses. When there is a B or O this denotes either Bayside (north-Gulf of Mexico side) or Oceanside (south-Atlantic Ocean side) location.

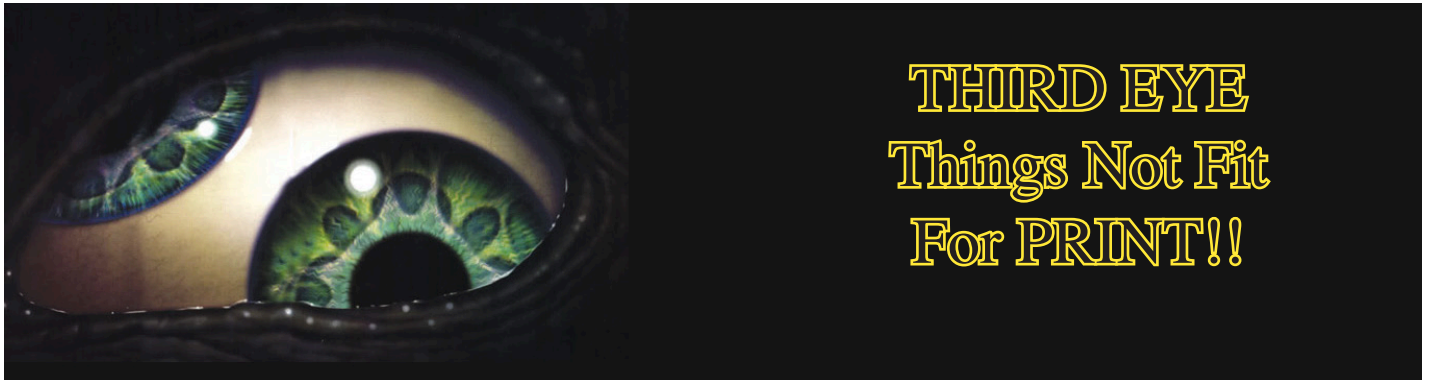

National Child Abuse Prevention Month

In 1983, President Reagan proclaimed April to be the first National Child Abuse Prevention Month.

Since then, National Child Abuse Prevention Month has been the catalyst that encourages communities to share child abuse and neglect prevention awareness strategies as well as activities to promote the social and emotional well-being of children and families.

Together we can protect today's youth and create safe, stable environments that allow youth to reach their full potential. Everyone can play a role in preventing child abuse and neglect and promoting child and family well-being.

How you can help?

- Volunteer your time in a child crisis shelter or parenting support program. Search for a Florida shelter near you.

- Arrange for a speaker on child abuse and neglect to come to your PTA, church, club or workplace.

- Call the national child abuse hotline 1-800-422-4453, your local law enforcement agency or Dept of Children and Families/child protective Services if you think a child is being neglected, sexually abused, physically abused or emotionally abused.

- Learn the protective factors to help eliminate abuse. Research suggest that certain characteristics, such as self-regulation skills, social competence, adaptive functioning, and self-esteem, help promote positive outcomes.

- Spread the word.

Every 10 seconds a report is made concerning a child being abused. Child abuse can lead to lifelong physical, emotional and psychological conditions. Each year in the U.S., more than 1,600 children die from abuse or neglect.

Here are a few signs that a child might be dealing with abuse:

- Shows sudden changes in behavior or school performance
- Has not received help for physical or medical problems brought to the parents' attention
- Is always watchful, as though preparing for something bad to happen
- Lacks adult supervision
- Is overly compliant, an overachiever or too responsible
- Comes to school early, stays late and does not want to go home
- Unexplainable injuries

Here are a few prevention strategies to share with families:

- Be a nurturing parent. Help a friend, neighbor or relative. Parenting is hard and a 24/7 job.
- Take a Parent Time Out. Monitor your child's television, video and Internet use. Make sure they aren't watching violent TV shows or playing violent games.

Report suspected abuse or neglect. If you believe a child has been or may be harmed, contact your local police department or CPS immediately.

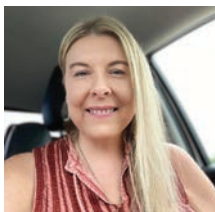
Ingredients:
